

## **Mt. Zion School District Safety Plan for COVID-19 September 3, 2020 Amendment**

1. Transition back from remote learning submitted with one week notice.
2. From the date of this change, the remote learning request form will only be accepted twice per semester, unless the student has not yet requested the full day remote.
3. Every other day/staggered days are no longer available after the 1st quarter, except when attending Richland or Technical Academy.
4. Phase 2 and 3- Teachers are expected to report to work as normal so you can use your classrooms, internet, technology, administrative support, and technical support while you deliver your instruction to students at home. Students will not be in the room while teachers are providing daily recorded relevant instruction ~~for at least 15 minutes~~ for each class of students. Instruction will be at the same frequency as when normally in session. Teachers will utilize live streaming/video conferencing for instruction and interaction with students at least once a week. In the event the building administrator determines, in its sole discretion, a teacher's recorded direct instruction is deficient in content or length, the building administrator shall notify the teacher in writing of the content deficiency and provide the teacher recommendations for improvement. In their discretion, the administrator can require the teacher to increase the length of his/her daily recorded, relevant instruction to at least 15 minutes for each class of instruction for 7-12 teachers/K-6 specialists and 60 minutes for K-6 classroom teachers.

(All references to required 15 and 60 minutes will be removed from the documents)

5. The District offers to adjust the student schedules to allow more preparation time for teachers, to be effective 6 days after the signing of this agreement, and through the end of the first semester. However, parents should be prepared for the possibility for this to continue through the remainder of the school year. The committee will reconvene December 1st to re-evaluate Wednesdays for the 3rd quarter.

Wednesdays during this time period will be considered Remote Learning Days for all learners. Teachers will provide an appropriate education and have time for planning and preparation.
