

# Mt. Zion School District Summer School High School Credit/Credit Recovery Courses June 3 – June 28, 2019

Mt. Zion School District is pleased to offer high school coursework that will allow students to earn ¼ unit of credit for Consumer Education and Driver Education or ½ unit recovery credit for high school English or Math. Out-of-District students are welcome based on availability. All building and room assignments will be provided when each course is confirmed to families. All course offerings are subject to minimum enrollment requirements with a full refund for classes not held.

### Course Description for High School Course Offerings:

**Driver Education Classroom Studies** – This course fulfills the classroom component of the driver’s education program. The aim of the class is to enable students to develop sound judgments and proper mental attitudes for the safe operation of a motor vehicle. Each student must attend at least 30 clock hours of classroom instruction and complete all required coursework and assignments to earn a passing grade for this phase of the driver education program. This course does not include behind-the-wheel instruction. Arrangements for behind-the-wheel instruction must be made with the high school of the student’s home district. Student must be 15 years-old on or before August 09, 2019 to enroll. Earns ¼ credit unit.\*

**Consumer Education** – Students will learn to become informed consumers and develop responsible attitudes toward the use of resources. They will explore goal setting decisions, personal budgeting and financial management through the use of checking accounts and credit. In addition, students will learn how to understand financial agreements with the use of used and new car purchases. Finally, car insurance and investment insurance policies will be evaluated to provide students with an understanding of real purchase decisions that they may soon be making. Each student must attend at least 30 clock hours of classroom instruction and successfully complete all required coursework and assignments to earn ¼ credit unit.\*

**English Survey** – This credit recovery course is designed for students needing ½ credit of high school English. This is an excellent opportunity for students who have not successfully completed the English requirement to earn credit towards graduation. Each student must attend at least 60 clock hours of classroom instruction and successfully complete all required coursework and assignments to earn ½ credit unit.

**Math Survey** – This credit recovery course is designed for students needing ½ credit of high school Math. This is an excellent opportunity for Pre-Algebra, Algebra 1, Algebra 2, or Geometry students to earn credit towards graduation. Students will be involved in a self-paced course. Each student must attend at least 60 clock hours of classroom instruction and successfully complete all required coursework and assignments to earn ½ credit unit.
