

**Resolution
Board of Education
Mt. Zion Community Unit School District #3**

“Prevailing Wage”

Whereas, the State of Illinois has enacted “An Act regulating wages of laborers, mechanics and other workers employed in any public works by the State, county, city or any public body or any political subdivision or by anyone under contract for public works,” approved June 26, 1941, as amended, (Ill. Rev. Stat. 48, par. 39s-9) and

Whereas, the aforesaid Act requires that Mt. Zion Community Unit School District #3, investigate and ascertain the prevailing rate of wages as defined in said Act for laborers, mechanics and other workers in the locality of said Macon County employed in performing construction of public works, for Mt. Zion Community Unit School District #3.

Now therefore, be it ordained by Mt. Zion Community Unit School District #3 – 1595 W. Main Street, Mt. Zion, IL 62549.

Section 1: To the extent and as required by “An Act regulating wages of laborers, mechanics, and other workers employed in any public works by State, county, city or any public body or any political subdivision or by anyone under contract for public works,” approved June 26, 1941, as amended, the general prevailing rate of wages in this locality for laborers, mechanics and other workers engaged in construction of public works coming under the jurisdiction of Mt. Zion Community Unit School District #3 is hereby ascertained to be the same as the prevailing rate of wages for construction work in the Macon County area as determined by the Department of Labor or the State of Illinois as of November 15, 2018 (or as updated by the State of Illinois), a copy of that determination being attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. As required by said Act, any and all revisions of the prevailing rate of wages by the Department of Labor or the State of Illinois shall supersede the Department’s June determination and apply to any and all public works construction undertaken by Mt. Zion Community Unit School District #3. The definition of any terms appearing in this Ordinance which are used to aforesaid Act shall be the same as in said Act.

Section 2: Nothing herein contained shall be construed to apply said general prevailing rate of wages as herein ascertained to any work or employment except public works construction of Mt. Zion Community Unit School District #3 to the extent required by the aforesaid Act.

Section 3: Mt. Zion Community Unit School District #3 shall publicly post or keep available for inspection by any interested party in the main office of the Mt. Zion Community Unit School District #3 this determination or any revisions of such prevailing rate of wage. A copy of this determination or of the current revised determination of prevailing rate of wages then in effect shall be attached to all contract specifications.

Section 4: Mt. Zion Community Unit School District #3 shall mail a copy of this determination to any employer, and to any association of employers and to any person or association of employees who have filed their names and addresses, requesting copies of any determination stating the particular rates and the particular class of workers whose wages will be affected by such rates.

Section 5: Mt. Zion Community Unit School District #3 shall promptly file a certified copy of this Ordinance with the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois.

Section 6: Mt. Zion Community Unit School District 3 shall place a link on the District website and such link shall constitute notice that the determination is effective and that this is the determination of the public body.


