

**Mt. Zion School District Summer School**  
**Entering Grade K-9 Skills Building/Promotion Classes**  
**June 3 – June 28, 2019**

Mt. Zion School District is pleased to offer skills building courses for students entering kindergarten through ninth grade. All courses are intended to make the transition to the next grade level an easier experience or to prove student readiness for promotion. The classes will meet for 2 hours each day, Monday-Friday, beginning June 3 and ending no later than June 28, 2019. All classes will be held at Mt. Zion Intermediate School, 310 S Henderson Street, Mt. Zion, IL. Minimum enrollment requirements apply with full refund for classes not held.

**Course Description for Early Literacy and Math (Entering Grades K-1)**

*10:00 a.m. – Noon*

This class is designed to meet the needs of pre-readers, beginning readers, and early mathematics learners who will be entering kindergarten or first grade. The goal of this program is to develop and reinforce the building block concepts and skills for reading and mathematics. Students are typically grouped to ensure growth. Student progress will be monitored throughout the course, and assessments used at McGaughey Elementary School will be used for final evaluation.

**Course Description for Basic Math and Reading Skills Classes (Entering Grades 2-4)**

*10:00 a.m. – Noon*

These classes are designed for reinforcement of basic reading, math, and language arts skills for those students who need to strengthen these areas. Students entering second and third grade will work on “learning to read” as well as “reading to learn”. Students entering fourth grade will work on the increased independence needed for the intermediate level while still supporting the needs of the students. Instructional activities will focus upon the fundamentals of reading and math with an emphasis on basic math facts, basic math concepts, reading comprehension, and general reading skills. Student progress will be monitored throughout the course. Assessment for second and third grade will be similar to that used at Mt. Zion Grade School, while assessment for fourth grade will be similar to that used at Mt. Zion Intermediate School.

**Course Description for Basic Math and Reading Skills (Entering Grades 5-9)**

*8:00 – 10:00 a.m.*

Instruction is aimed at reinforcing reading, math, and language arts skills for those students who need to strengthen these areas. Students will be exposed to a variety of reading materials and mathematics concepts needed for success and increased independence in the next grade level. Students will be assessed throughout the course using assignments and assessments common for their grade levels at Mt. Zion Intermediate School and Mt. Zion Junior High School.
