

**Mt. Zion School District Summer School**  
**Junior High Skills Building/Promotion Classes**

Mt. Zion School District is pleased to offer three new in-person courses specifically designed to improve knowledge and ability in math and language arts for students currently enrolled at Mt. Zion Junior High School. Arrangements may be made for a student to participate in two courses if needed. Each class will meet in two separate sections each day, 2 hours each section, Monday-Friday, beginning June 1 and ending no later than June 28, 2021. All classes will be held at Mt. Zion Junior High School, 315 S Henderson Street, Mt. Zion, IL. Minimum enrollment requirements may apply with full refund for classes not held.

**Course Description for MA 2107 – Fundamentals and Foundations for Pre Algebra**

*Section 1 - 7:45-9:45 a.m.*

*Section 2 - 10:00 a.m. – Noon*

This course will focus on whole numbers, integers, rational numbers, conversion of measurements, fractions, decimals, percents, exponents, radicals, LCM, and GCM. Basic algebraic properties of solving, factoring, and graphing, including slope, will also be addressed. Section placement dependent upon enrollment.

**Course Description for MA 2189 – Algebra Boot Camp**

*Section 1 - 7:45-9:45 a.m.*

*Section 2 - 10:00 a.m. – Noon*

This course will review the study of sets, operations, properties, equations, inequalities, factors, polynomials, linear sentences, rational expressions, radicals, and quadratics. Section placement dependent upon enrollment.

**Course Description for LC217 and LC218 – Literature and Composition**

*Section 1 - 7:45-9:45 a.m.*

*Section 2 - 10:00 a.m. – Noon*

In this course, students will use grade specific texts in order to learn a story’s plot, character, and setting develop and interact. They will also be writing text-based informational and/or argumentative papers in order to show character development over time. Real-world connections will also be made through the use of related non-fiction articles. Section placement dependent upon enrollment.
